Special Seminar for Young Professionals "Tools and Techniques of Project Management"

The course outline:

This short course provides an overview of project management tools and techniques. The aim is to provide people who have a technical background an insight into the technical aspects of project management. Most project management software tools perform these calculations without the user needing to perform the number crunching. However, for a project manager to be effective; an understanding of how these calculations are done is important. Such an understanding allows the project manager to forecast potential problems and take corrective action. The focus is thus on an understanding of the critical path method (CPM) and the project evaluation and review technique PERT). Project costs and risk analysis are also covered. This seminar is based on a course the presenter conducts at the Sydney Institute of TAFE, Ultimo Campus. The full course is normally delivered over an 18 week period, with 4 contact hours per week.
